All matches in Main Draw shall be played on knockout basis and best of three games of 21 points in rally point system.

M&C / M&Q List will be published on 25 June 2024. It shall be the responsibility of the players to ensure that all the entries forwarded appear in the List. If there is any omission, the player/s concerned immediately should contact DCBA. After the Last date, no complaints shall be entertained for omission of any entry. DCBA will

not be responsible for any omissions of names thereafter.

- In case of common players from District eligibility list, Previous year (2023) district champion, DCBA Ranking, BAI Ranking & BWF Ranking, no reserve /extra players are eligible from the respective District Associations.
- In case players need to partner outside of their District, the entry will be treated as a District Quota Entry. No extra entries will be accepted in the main draw.



Tournament Seeding

As per the current ranking on DCBA Website (i.e. 06th June 2024)

Aadhar Card Verification If there is any protest against a player, immediate Aadhar card verification will be conducted. Therefore, a player must be prepared for random Aadhar Card Verification. Please ensure that all players have their Aadhar cards available for verification during the tournament. If a player is denying for Aadhar verification (**Aadhar history Verification**), their entry will be withdrawn from the tournament. **Ref No. – BAI/GEN/BAI** ID/075/2024 dated 11th June 2024 &

BAI/AADHAR/VERIFICATION/078/2024 dated 12th June 2024.

A non-refundable fee of **Rs 3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand)** will be charged against age protest. Each complaint or protest will be forwarded to DCBA and course of action

Protest :: will be decided by the Administrator / Appointed Tournament committee.

Line judges may not be appointed for the matches till the quarterfinals. Thereafter on

Line Judges :: the request of the players.

To protect the integrity, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- ➤ Any (Player/ Student/ Participant) residing/ studying/ Working (office) in Delhi or Registered Delhi State Players (Having Active BAI Player ID) can participate in the proposed **DELHI STATE BADMINTON CHAMPIONSHIPS (U11, U13, U19, Senior's & Veterans) 2024.**
- ➤ However, a Player/ Student/ Participant, Residing/ Studying/ Working (Office) in Delhi but registered with any <u>other State / District Badminton Association</u> other than Delhi cannot participate in this proposed DELHI STATE BADMINTON CHAMPIONSHIPS (U11, U13, U19, Senior's & Veterans) 2024.
- ➤ All players must carry your Aadhar Card, Current Year School ID Card or Office ID-Card, Date of Birth Certificate issued by the MCD and registered in the same year.
- > If the Date of Birth and its Registration is not of the same year, then player must submit Medical Certificate as per BAI format and Average AGE will be calculated as per the Medical Certificate.
- ➤ In Paired events both players must mention partner name. Entry shall not be accepted without the partner's name.
- Each player will pay his own entry fees (e.g., For Doubles event entry fees is 1000 Rs. for each player).
- ➤ In paired events partners should play in same sports attire.
- > Player should be prepared to play his/her next match with a rest period of maximum 30 minutes.
- > Players are the solely responsible for their belongings at the venue. Organizer will not be responsible for any loss.
- > All the players participating in this tournament shall maintain strict discipline on & off the court.
- > The Organizers are not responsible for any mishap, inside/outside the venue during the tournament.
- ➤ All the players are supposed to report at least **45 minutes** before their actual match timing.
- > The Matches will be played according to the Schedule and No match will be Rescheduled. If the player is not found at the scheduled time of his/her match, walkover shall be given.
- ➤ The Decision of the Tournament Committee will be the final on all Points of Facts.

 The Chief Referee will be the Sole in charge of all Technical Issues on Point of Law.
- ➤ Entries shall be sent through www.badmintondelhi.org online only and entry fees shall be submitted through QR Code.
